GSSNE's MIRA HOFFMAN AWARD

Description

Recognizes an unwavering commitment to the Girl Scout movement within GSSNE with a focus on the outdoor experience. The recipient has made outstanding contributions to the work of council and displays the finest spirit of Girl Scouting.

Criteria

MEMBERSHIP: The candidate is a currently registered member of GSSNE in good standing and successfully completed all applicable training
FOCUS: Service benefits the entire council
LENGTH: Minimum 10 years through 9/30 of this calendar year

Nomination

NOMINATION: 1 from any GSSNE member
ENDORSEMENTS: 2 from individuals familiar with the candidate's service, other than the nominator; at least one endorsement letter must be from an adult not related to the candidate.

Nominee Example

A Girl Scout member for 11 years, this candidate was a troop leader for 9 years, service unit outdoor advocate for 3, Camp Director for 5 years, and council troop camp trainer for 6. This volunteer introduced the outdoor adventure to dozens upon dozens of girls by organizing community camping events, taking her Girl Scouts on T.R.E.C. adventures, and helping to enrich council trainings by participating in think tanks.
